

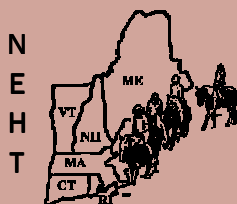

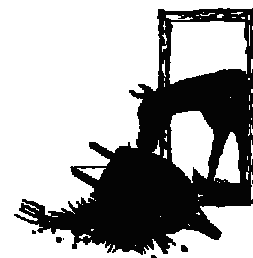

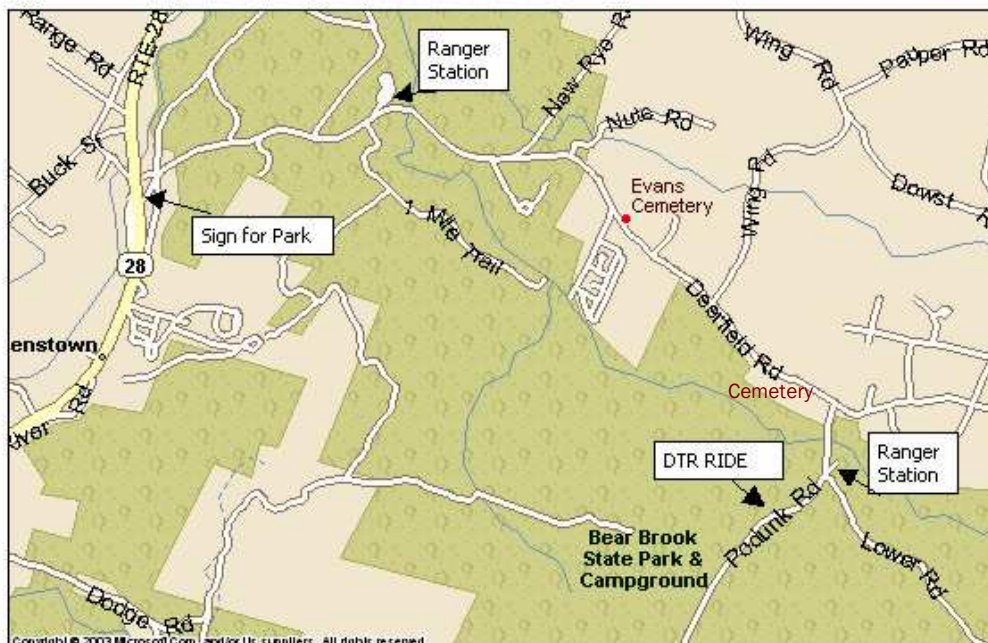
UNJUDGED PLEASURE TRAIL RIDE

TWO ROUTES OFFERED OF APPROX. 9 & 18 MILES
Both loops are suitable for all levels of riders -

THE TRAIL

will be old woods road, gravel road and trails

Directions to Bear Brook State Park Allenstown, NH Hayes Field, off Podunk Rd



DIRECTIONS

FROM THE SOUTH— Take Rte 93 N to Exit 9N (Hooksett) - Take Rte 3 through Hooksett to Allenstown and take a right on Rte 28

FROM THE NORTH—Take Rte 93 S to Exit 13 (Rte 3S) Go through Concord until you get to Allenstown and make a left on Rte 28

FOLLOW RTE 28 for about 4 miles and you will see a sign on the right for Bear Brook State Park—Take a right on Deerfield Road into the park and stay on Deerfield Rd, pass through the first Ranger Station, pass New Rye Road and continue until you see a right on Podunk Rd. There will be State Park Signs and a sign for Hayes Field. Pavement will turn to gravel and Hayes Field will be approximately 3/4 of a mile down on the right

We hope that you can join us
